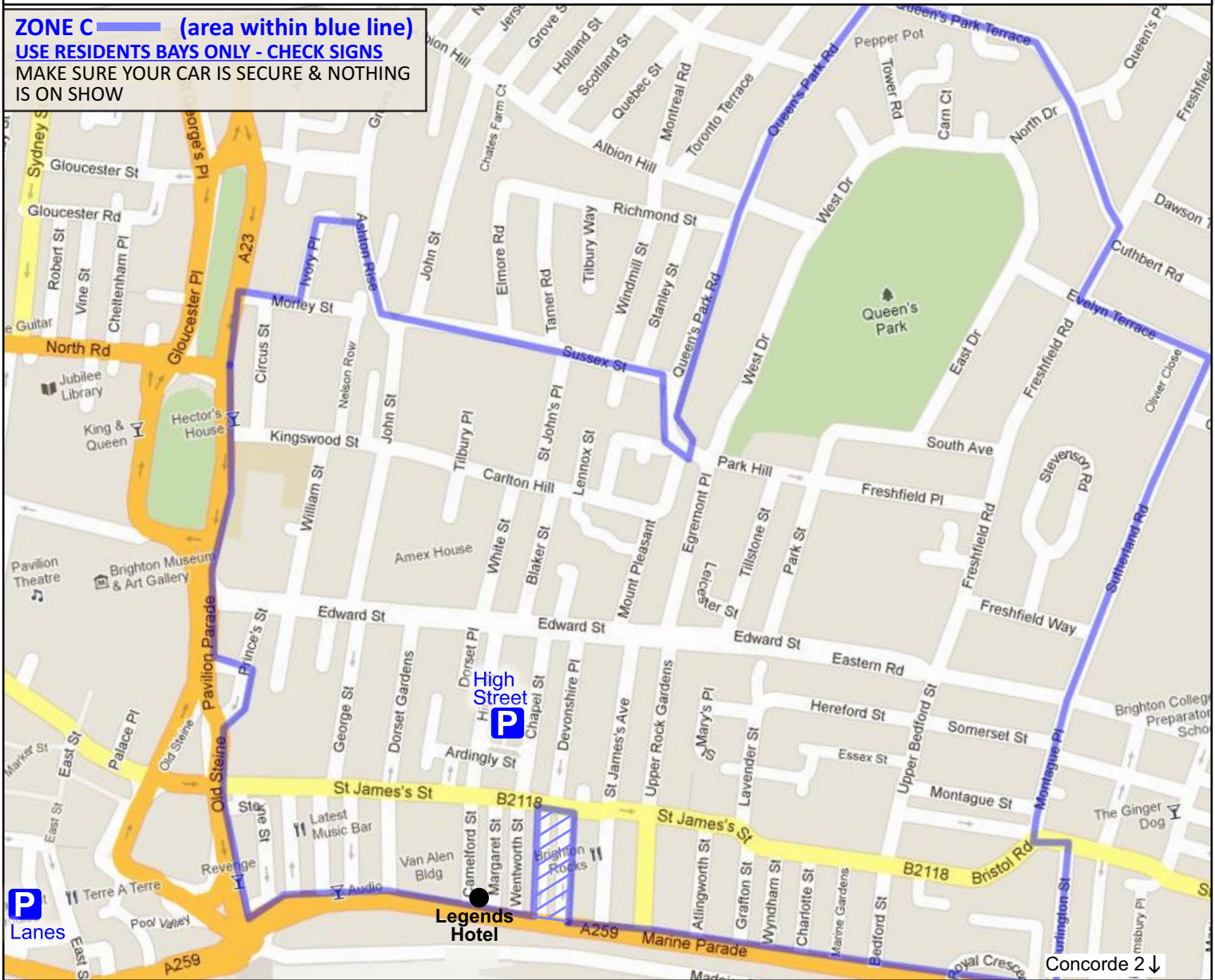


Parking information:

As a courtesy we offer discounted Voucher Parking for guests (see below).
At busy times it may be easier to use the other parking options outlined below.
(Unsure? Stop safely in front of the hotel and pop into reception for parking advice).



ZONE C (area within blue line)
USE RESIDENTS BAYS ONLY - CHECK SIGNS
MAKE SURE YOUR CAR IS SECURE & NOTHING IS ON SHOW



PUBLIC CAR PARKS

High Street (underground)
£18.20 24hrs (card/cash)

Lanes (underground)
£23-£25 for 24hrs (cash only)

All car parks are private unless otherwise stated and you will be clamped if you use them. **Note: Vouchers cannot be used in public car parks**

PAY & DISPLAY (£7.20- £15.60 for 11 hours)

On Madeira Drive and New Steine, payment information on machines.
All Pay & Display machines allow payment by phone and some accept cash.

DISABLED BAYS - (free parking with a valid [Blue badge](#))
Ardingly Street, Chapel Street, Devonshire Place & Madeira Place. [Blue badge holders](#) may also park free in pay & display bays & High Street car park.

ZONE C - VOUCHER PARKING (£10.00)

The cheapest way to park but these cannot be reserved so you will need to find a space (spaces are limited). It's advisable to arrive before 3.30pm or after 7.30pm.

24 hours permits allow parking on-street in residents bays, which include most streets near the hotel. Some bays are pay & display only or shared, so please check for the signs shown below. [Marine Parade, Madeira Drive & New Steine are NOT in Zone C. Vouchers cannot be used in car parks](#)

IMPORTANT: Do not scratch off permit until you have found a space. If you see any sign other than those shown here do not **NOT** park.

Oversized vehicle or van? Parking is for 'Private Motor Cars' but many Pay & display bays on Madeira Drive are suitable for large vehicles. They offer good value and are just a short walk away.
